Abstract and Presentation Guidelines

We are **now accepting abstract** submissions from ALL diabetes researchers (including undergraduates and graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, residents, fellows, technicians, research associates and community members) who have research projects in any field related to diabetes.

The deadline for abstract submissions is 11:59 p.m. CST **October 2nd, 2023**. Please send your submissions in a Word document to dream@chrom.ca.

Abstracts should be submitted using 12-point font, with a maximum of 300 words, excluding title, authors and affiliations. Abstracts should be broken down into clearly identifiable components of Background/Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusions/Importance. The abstracts and posters should clearly state the research findings and should not be open-ended.

All submissions will be asked to do a poster presentation in the format below

Dimensions: 90 cm width and 60 cm length (QR code is optional)

Poster Session Details:

The poster session will be held on Nov. 15th from 4:30 p.m.-6:30 p.m. at the Fort Garry Hotel. The presentation will be 7 minutes total (5-minute presentation followed by 2 minutes of questions).

Awards:

Financial awards will be given to the top 3 poster presentations.
